1104 in the Western Communities and 436 in the Saanich Peninsula.



Priority Referral System

Phase 1 of the Priority Referral System has launched

The Priority Referral Form is completed by a physician when treating a complex patient who does not have a primary care provider and is determined by the physician to be a priority for the Health Connect Registry (HCR.)

To use the referral form simply complete all fields (by hand or type into the fillable form) and fax to 778-698-4569.

The HCR in Greater Victoria (SP/WC/Victoria) accepts Priority Referrals from:

- Urgent Primary Care Centres
- Walk-in Clinics
- BC Cancer-Victoria
- Heart Failure Clinics
- Memory Clinics
- Palliative Care Teams
- Maternity Clinics
- MHSU Clinics
- Retiring/leaving/downsizing Practitioners

Please note:

- Patients must give consent to being registered on the HCR as a priority patient
- Submitting the form does not guarantee attachment; patients on the HCR will be contacted directly when a practitioner becomes available.
- We work in partnership with Primary Care Networks (PCNs) throughout the region. When appropriate, the information collected may be shared with other PCN communities to expedite patient attachment in each region.


