Panel Management for Patient Care

The goal of panel management is to help family physicians understand their patients and what those patients need. It is a key step to establishing a patient medical home.

A new three-phase approach to panel management is now available through the GPSC and PSP. Because family doctors and their practice teams will likely need to spend additional time and effort to improve the accuracy of panel data and to proactively manage the chronic and preventative care needs of their patient panel, a new incentive payment valued at \$6,000 is available to eligible physicians who wish to participate in Panel Management activity.
